TRAVEL+PARKING

Please follow signs for Park & Ride on arrival in Fort William.

TRAVEL

Most of you will be coming from the south - remember there are no motorways north of Perth and Glasgow - but some glorious scenery instead. Basic road directions are on the website (www.fortwilliamworldcup.co.uk), together with public transport options. The postcode is PH33 6SQ, but follow signs (not sat nav) when you get to Fort William.

CYCLEWAY

The offroad cycleway from Fort William to Torlundy and then to the World Cup Village, is a safe, easy and fun way to get to the heart of the action. The Bike Park will be operational on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Remember your bike lock.

EVENT PARKING

There will be no spectator parking in the Nevis Range car park which will be taken over by the World Cup Village on Thursday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday. There will be a £5 charge to park at the Rural Complex, on the Nevis Range access road, about 1km from the World Cup Village. A footpath takes you straight to the World Cup Village and there will be a limited shuttle bus service for the very old, very young or infirm.

When parking at the Rural Complex is full, you will be directed to the free Park & Ride at Blar Mhor, just outside Fort William on the A830 Mallaig road.

PARK & RIDE (SAT & SUN)

There is a free shuttle service from the Park & Ride facility just outside Fort William. This is the easiest way of getting straight to the main entrance of the event. Shuttle buses will operate from the Park and Ride to the World Cup Village. There is also public parking in Fort William itself - at An Aird and the West End car parks. This parking is subject to normal rates (£5 per day).

Please note that campervans/motorhomes/vehicles adapted for sleeping are only permitted to park between 08:00 and 21:00 in the long stay car parks.

Please take note of signs advising when car parks are full and follow the directions of Police, Traffic Wardens and our own Parking Stewards.

FREE SHUTTLE BUSES

Free shuttle buses will operate on 3 routes. The service runs on Saturday and Sunday only.

All shuttle buses will be clearly marked and will run continuously until all spectators have left the World Cup Village after racing.

FREE SHUTTLE BUSES Saturday and Sunday only

ROUTE 1

(Red route) Town Centre

Starts at West end on the High Street, behind WH Smiths on Middle St, then service stops between Ellis Brigham and the Lochaber Leisure Complex and opposite Nevis Bank Hotel near Glen Nevis roundabout.

ROUTE 2

(Green route)

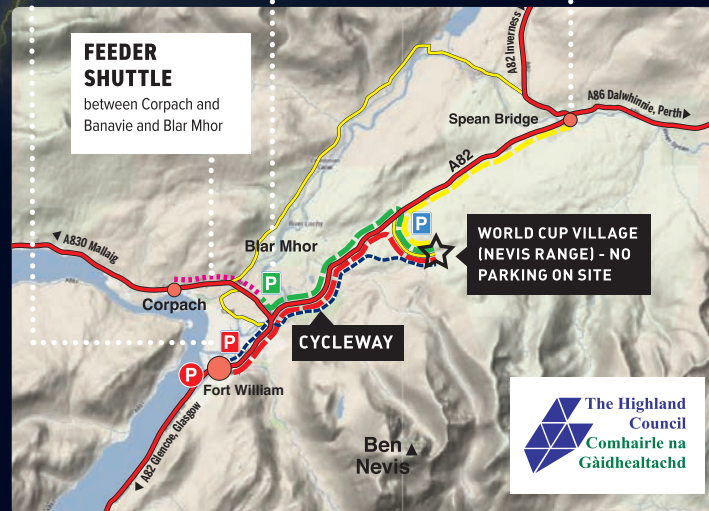
Blar Mhor Park & Ride

Free parking courtesy of Highland Council. There is a feeder shuttle between Corpach, Banavie and Blar Mhor with a number of marked stops.

ROUTE 3

(Yellow route) Spean Bridge

Pick up at service stop on A82 between the Spean Bridge Hotel and the Bridge Cafe. Important: There is no dedicated World Cup parking in Spean Bridge itself. This service is for overnight visitors and the local community who can walk to the bus stop.
